

## RIGHT- OF - WAY.

For and in consideration of Thirty-two (\$32.00) dollars to us in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we Elizabeth Self, widow, Martha F. Boling (nee Self) Mary L. Harwell (nee Self) James R. Self, Hallie G. Chester, Norma B. Chester Norman C. Chester, single, Samantha E. Viewton (nee Self) John B. Self and Wm. B. Self do hereby grant to The Prairie Oil & Gas Company, its successors or assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain, operate and remove, a pipe line for the transportation of oil or gas and erect, maintain and operate a telegraph or telephone line, if the same shall be found necessary, on over and through Our inherited lands, situated in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, described as follows, to-wit:

SE1/4 of SE1/4 Section 24, Township 17 N, Range 12 E, W1/2 of SW1/4 Section 19, Township 17 N, Range 13 E both of above tracts, being the allotment of John B. Self deceased, with ingress and egress to and from the same. The said grantors, heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except for the purposes hereinbefore granted to the said The Prairie Oil & Gas Company, which hereby agrees to pay any damages which may arise from the laying, maintaining and operating said pipe line: said damage if not mutually agreed upon, to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons, one thereof to be appointed by the said grantors, heirs or assigns, one by The Prairie Oil & Gas Company its successors or assigns, and the third by the two so appointed as aforesaid and the award of such three persons shall be final and conclusive. And it is hereby further agreed, that the said The Prairie Oil & Gas Company, its successors or assigns, may at any time lay an additional line of pipe alongside of the first line as herein provided, upon the payment of a like consideration, and subject to the same conditions, also to have the right to change the size of its pipes, the damage if any in making such change to be paid by the said The Prairie Oil & Gas Company. All pipes to be buried below plow depth.
