

## ASSIGNMENT.

COMPARED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: ) That A. D. Hayes, party of the first part/ for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, has, on this day, bargained and sold, and by these presents, does grant, and convey, unto C. J. Wrightman and to C. W. Butterworth, parties of the second part, and to each of them an undivided one-third (1/3) interest in and to a certain coal lease owned by the said party of the first part, executed by Chief Harrison, as guardian of Anna Harrison, a minor, on the 7th day of October, 1909, wherein the said party of the first part is grantee, and which lease covers, for coal mining purposes, the Southwest quarter of Section Ten (10), in Township Nineteen (19), north, of Range Thirteen (13) East, T. M. , in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, which said lease was filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Tulsa County, on the 25th day of October, 1909, and is recorded in Book 73, at page 89 of Miscellaneous Records.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE said estate unto the said parties of the second part, and to their heirs, administrators, executors and assigns, during the full term of said lease, and the parties of the second part hereby covenants and agree that to the extent of their several respective interests they will keep and perform the covenants of said lease, on the part of the grantee to be kept/performed.

It is the intent and purpose of this agreement to vest in the said A. D. Hayes, C. W. Butterworth and C. J. Wrightman, and each of them an equal undivided one-third (1/3) interest in said leasehold estate.
