TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING;

WHEREAS, a townsit e commission, heretofore appointed and acting under the authority of the act of Congress approved March 1, 1901 (31 Stat/861), agreement ratified by the Creek Nation May 25, 1901, has appraised the lots in the town of mulsa, Muskogee (Creek) Nation, I ndian Territory and

Whereas, the plat of said town was approved by the Secretary of the Interior on the 11th day of April 1902 and was duly place on file; and

whereas, the said commission has appraised all of the town lots included in said plat at their true <u>ualue</u>, excluding improvements, which appraisal has been approved by the Secretary of the Interior; and

Whereas, the said commission has awarded the real estate described hereinbelow to Washington M. Wilson and Edward F. Hannon, who has paid Your & 50/100 (\$4.50) pollars the full amount of the purchase price, into the treasury of the United States, to the credit of the Muskogee or Creek Nation of Indians, with the United States Indian Agent, at Muskogee Indian Territory, and is therefore, entitled to a patent;

Now, Therefore, I, the undersigned, the Principal chief of the Puskogee (Greek) Nation, do by virtue of the power and authority vested in my by the aforesaid Act of the Congress of the United States, hereby grant, sell and convey unto said Washinton M. Wilson and Edward F. Hannon, heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title and interest of the Muskogee (Creek-Noation, aforesaid, in and to Part of Lot Numbered 6, in Block Numbered 14, described as that part of Lot 6, in clock 14, which lies Northwesterly from a line which is parallel to and 50 feet northwesterly from the lot line between Lots 5 and 6 in the town of culsa, Muskogee, (Creek) Nation, Indian Territory and according to the plat thereof on file as aforesaid.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I the principal chief of the Muskogee (Creek) Nation,
