WARRANTY DEED.

COMPARED

THIS INDENTURE, made this 2nd day of November 1909, between Frank C/ Giddings, (unmarried) of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma of the first part, and Clyde E. Middleton, of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma of the second part.

WITNESS, That said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Fifty \$150.00 Dollars, to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents, grant, bargain, remise, release, sell, convey and confirm unto the said part.... of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all of his right, title and interest in and to the following described real estate lying and situated in the county of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit.

The West half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of Lot Ten (10) Block Ten (10) in Highlands Addition to Tulsa, Okla., according to the plat thereof filed and of Record in the office of the Recorder in and for the county of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma.
