AGRICULTURAL LEASE.

THIS LEASE, Made and entered into this first day of Nov, 1904, by and between Wannie Barnett & Joe Barnett, of Bixby, Oklahoma, hereinafter called the lessors and J. M. Purell, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, hereinafter called the lessee, witnesseth:

1. That the lessors owns the following described real estate and premises, situate in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 11, Township 16, R- 13, East.

2. That the lessors, in consideration of the covenants, promises and agreements herein contained and expressed, hereby rents, leases, and lets to the lessee the above described premises to have and to hold the same from the first day of Nov, 1909 to the first day of Nov^{em}. 1914, together with the buildings and improvements thereon, for agricultural purposes.

3. That the lessors covenants to place the lessee in the quiet and peaceable possession of said premises on or before the beginning of the
