

The party of the second part shall have the right to discharge any incumbrance on said premises, and shall have a lien thereon for the amount so paid, together with all costs and expenses incurred.

Said lessee shall have the right to surrender this lease at any time and such surrender shall operate as a cancellation of this lease and extinguishment of all rights hereunder of both lessee and lessor.

This contract shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, assigns, successors and personal representatives of the parties hereto.

# OIL AND GAS LEASE.

COMPARED

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 3rd day of November, 1909 by and between Rosa Foreman (formerly Rosa Frye) and Robert Foreman, her husband, parties of the first part, and P. K. F. Church and J. M. Brown, parties of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar (\$1.00) to them in hand well and truly paid by the said parties of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained on the part of the said parties of the second part to be paid, kept and performed, have granted, demised, leased and let and by these presents do grant, lease and let unto the said parties of the second part, their successors or assigns, for the sole and only purpose of mining and operating for oil and gas, and of laying pipe lines and of building tanks, stations and structures thereon to take care of said products, all that certain tract of land situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
