lying out side, in a wild and uncultivated state; that a large hill covers all of said land excepte about forth (40) acres.

Your petitioner, further represents that it is to the best interest of his said ward that said lease be approved and that said leases be granted the said term for the purpose of improvement of said premises; that the improvements and rental derived from same under said lease will be a greater benefit to his said ward than the use of said land for other purposes; that said lesses is a proper person to occupy and cultivate said land; and that said land lies nearest to Broken Arrow, Indian Territory than to any other marker.
