TRANSFER OF LEASEHOLD ESTATE.

THIS INDENTURE made the 10th, day of June, in the year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nine, between Samuel Rabinowitz of Marietta Ohio, party of the first part, and Bernard Revel and Sarah Rabinowitz of the same place, parties of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, an undivided one half working interest in and to that certain leasehold estate for oil and gas purposes made and executed by George W. Adams to P. J. And Thos. White and W. G. Lewis in the fall of the year 1908, leasing the Adams' farm in the North West of the North West Quarter, Section 24, Township 20 of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, which lease is duly recorded in the office of the Recorder of Tulsa County, at Tulsa, Oklahoma, to which reference is hereby made, for a full description of said lease said lease being the same now owned and being operated by the said first party; together with a like interest in the three producing oil wells situate upon said ^{lease} lands as well as the machinery, tanks, tubing, casing, tools, fixtures, appurtenances and appliances now situate thereon and thereunto belonging, and also a like interest in the oil produced from said premises on and after the first day of June 1909.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE ABOVE GRANTED estate unto the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, subject however, to all the terms and conditions of this agreement, and to all the terms and conditions contained in the lease hereinbefore mentioned and to which reference is hereby made.

IT IS AGREED, By and between the parties hereto that the estate herein is granted on the condition that on or before the 24th, day of June 1909, Benard Revel and Sarah Rabinowitz, the said parties of the second part, shall intermarry and that if such marriage shall not occur, this conveyance is to be null and void
