FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF Twenty-two & 50/100 Dollars, to him in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Isla M. Lynch, a minor, by William Lynch, guardian, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, does hereby grant, to the OKLAHOMA NATURAL GAS COMPANY, a corporation, its successors or assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain, operate, re-lay and remove pipe lines for the transportation of gas through certain lands situate in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, described as follows: The North one-half of South East Quarter of Section 34, Township 20, North Range 15 East, with ingress and egress to and from the same at and upon the line of present survey. The said grantors, heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except for the purposes hereinbefore granted to the said OKLAHOMA NATURAL GAS COMPANY, which hereby agrees to pay any damages which may arise to crops and fences from the laying, maintaining and operating said pipe line; it is agreed between the parties to this agreement that the second party is to have the privilege of reserving so much of the coal underlying said line as may be necessary for its support, the Royalty interest in said coal of 25¢ per ton, to be paid for at the time the excavation reaches the Right of Way of said pipe line and the thickness of said coal to be governed by that of adjacent opening.
