

Company, as aforesaid and to be paid from the same and due and owing her by the said M. H. Bassett as trustee for her, the sum of five Thousand five hundred thirty-three dollars and eighty seven cents and that there remains at this time on deposit with the said Union Trust company, after deducting the sum of one hundred fifty dollars, which said Union Trust Company advanced to said Mary C. Bassett, for the funeral expenses of the said Martin H. Bassett the sum of five thousand one hundred thirty-five dollars and nine cents (\$5135.09) which the Court finds should be paid over to the said Mary C. Bassett, as her separate property and the court further finds that the said sum of money which the said Martin H. Bassett paid on the property purchased from John O. Mitchell, aforesaid, having been paid out of her separate funds and with the intention by the said Martin H. Bassett, of placing the title in the said Mary C. Bassett, as soon as the building was completed thereon, that that property of right and in equity should and does belong to the said Mary C. Bassett.

It is therefore considered, ordered adjudged and decreed that the said real estate described in the petition and as herein set forth be and the same is hereby ordered and declared to belong to Mary C. Bassett, as her separate property and the fee simple title is hereby confirmed in her and it is further ordered, adjudged and decreed, that the said sum of five thousand one hundred thirty-five dollars and nine cents (\$5139.09) now remaining in the Union Trust Company, of Tulsa, be and is hereby confirmed in her as her property and the said Union Trust Company is hereby ordered to pay the same over to her and that the costs of this proceeding be and are hereby taxed against the plaintiff including a fee for the guardian ad litem, for H. W. Randolph for \$15.00
