COMPARED

AGREEMENT.

THIS AGREEMENT: Made and entered into this 20th day of November 1909 by and between C. C. Drew of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the first part, and John F. Lawrence of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the second part, Witnesseth:

That for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar and other good and valuable considerations paid by said second party unto said first party, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said first party hereby leases and lets unto said second party for a term of five (5) years beginning March 1, 1910, the following described premises situated in Tulsa county, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

the office rooms, one 15x24, one 16x24, one 12x24, and one 9x12 being on the ground floor in the rear of the bank rooms of the first floor of the five story building known as the Drew building, situated on the corner of Boston and Third Streets in said City of Tulsa, and located upon the following described premises.

Fifty (50) feet East and West by One Hundred (100) feet North and south off of the East end of Lot Three (3) in Block One hundred and five
