

The lessee shall have the right to use sufficient water, gas or oil to run all necessary machinery for operating wells, and also the right to remove all his property at any time during the life of this lease.

It is agreed and understood between the parties hereto that the lessee may surrender this grant at any time by paying the amount then due on the same together with the additional sum of one dollar and releasing the same of record, and thereby be released from all further liabilities. The lessee further agrees to continue to pay the one dollar (\$1.00) per acre yearly rental as aforesaid, until a well or wells are drilled and the product of the same well or wells are being sold off the premises. Then the above mentioned one-eighth part of the oil and one Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) yearly rental for each gas well shall apply and not before.

It is understood between the parties to this agreement that all conditions between the parties hereunto shall extend to their successors, heirs, executors and assigns.
