The lessee shall have the right to use sufficient water, gas or oil to ben all necessary machinery for operating wells, and also the right to remove all his property at any time curing the life of this lease.

It is agreed and understood between the parties hereto that the lessec may surrender this grant at any time by paying the amount then cue on the same together with the additional sum of one dollar and releasing the same of record, and thereby he released from all further liabilities. lessee further agrees to continue to pay the one dollar (\$1.00) per acre yearly mental as aforesaid, until a well or wells are drilled and the product of the same well of wells are being sold off the premises. Then the above mentioned one-eighth part of the oil and one Hundred Fifty Pollars (\$150.00) yearly rental for each gas well shall apply and not before.

It is understood between the parties to this agreement that all conditions between the parties hereunto shall extend to their successors, heirs executors and assigns.
