CONVEYANCE OF OIL AND GAS MINING RIGHTS UNDER
ORDER OF CONFIRMATION OF SALE.

THIS INDENTURE made this 10 day of December 1909, by and between Florence M. Dilley, of Tulsa County, Oklahoma guardian of the estate of William Alexander, a minor, of the first part, and E. Goodman of Tulsa county, Oklahoma, of the second part.

witnesseth: that, whereas, the said Florence M. Dilley, grantor, was duly and legally appointed guardian of the estate of William Alexander, a minor, by the Probate Court of Tulsa county, State of Oklahoma, said court having jurisdiction of said cause, and that thereafter the said Florence M. Dilley filed a bond as required by the order of said court and by law, and took oath as required by law, whereupon the letters of guardianship in the matter of the estate of said minor were

issued to said Florence M. Dilley;

whereas, on the 18th day of October 1909 said guardian filed her verified petition praying for an order decreeing the sale of the oil and gas mining rights of said minor in and to the premises hereinafter described: and
