

## AFFIDAVIT AFFECTING TITLE TO REAL ESTATE.

Price of Tulsa, Oklahoma being first duly sworn on oath states that he was the owner of part of Lot 5 block 7, Described as all that part of Lot 5 which has a frontage of 32 feet on Main Street and a depth of 140 feet to the alley and adjoining Lot 4, with a uniform width of 32 feet in Tulsa, Creek Nation, Indian Territory on the 15th day of August 1903 that he is the Prior L. Price to whom patent was issued on the 15th day of August 1903, and approved by the secretary of the Interior on the 5th day of November 1903, that he sold 22 feet of the land conveyed to him by said patent on the 26th day of May 1903 to B. L. Conway and that in signing said warranty deed he signed as P. L. Price instead of Prior L. Price, as his name appears in the patent issued on the day and year above mentioned, and that the person who signed the deed to B. L. Conway for the 22 feet of ground, by 140 feet in depth in Lot 5, in block 7, is the same person whose name appears as Prior L. Price in patent above referred to.

That whereas the following described property all of lots (2) <sup>two</sup> and (3) to three in block numbered (5) five, in Red Fork, Okla., as shown by the recorded plat thereof.

situated in the incorporated town of Red Fork, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, was subject to taxation for the year of 1905-6 and whereas the taxes assessed on said real property for the said year of 1905-6 aforesaid remained due and unpaid at the date of the sale hereinafter named, and whereas the collector of revenue of the said town did on the 4th day of November 1907 by virtue of the authority in him vested by law, at the sale begun and publicly held on the 4th day of November 1907 in the year of 1907 expose to public sale at Red Fork, in said Tulsa County, in substantial conformity with all the requirements of statute in such case made and provided, the real property above described for the payment of the taxes, penalty and cost then due and remaining unpaid on said property; and whereas at
