ACKNOWLECGMENT OF LIEN

Whereas, Albert H. Collins a intermarried white person has certain valuable improvements on the N W 5.97 acres, Lot 4: W 12.81 acres Lot 5, S ec 6, T. 20 N, R. 13E. which were appraised under said Act at \$84 .31; and

Whereas, I Frank B. Ridge have selected said land in allotment for myself and by such action declared my intention of purchasing the improvements thereon at the aforesaid price, and acquiescense in the operation of said Act of March 2, 1907.

I do hereby acknowledge that a lien is, by virtue of said act, visited on the rents and profits of said land, which lien shall be enforceable in any court of competent jurisdiction, out of the rents and profits issuing from said land; conditioned that said sum of \$84.3L remains unpaid.
