We, the undersigned, C. W. Veitch of Vincennes, Indiana and E. F. Blaise of Tulsa, Oklahoma, doing business under the name and style of C. W. Veitch & Company, hereby stipulate and agree with J.B.Taggart of Tulsa, Oklahoma that said J.B. Taggart has a one-quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) carried interest in the oil and gas mining lease covering the following described land and now standing in the name of C. W. Veitch & Company, to-wit:

East hald of the northwest quarter of section eighteen, township twenty-one north, range thirteen east, it being understood by and between all of the parties hereto that said J.B.Taggart's interest in said above described lease shall be carried by said C.
