GENERAL WARRANTY DEED

Witnesseth: That said first parties for and in consideration of the money paid and to be paid by said second party to said first parties, as follows, to-wit:

\$153.00 pollars in cash upon the execution and delivery of this deed: \$250.00/100 Dollars six months after the date hereof; and \$250.00/100 dollars twelve months after the date hereof, with interest on said deferred payments at the rate of six per cent per annum from date.

Do by these presents grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part heirs and assigns all of the following described real estate lying and being situate in the County of Tulsa, in the State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
