valid and perfect, and that the defendants or either of them have no right, title, claim or interest in or to said lot, and that they and each of them are perpetually barred and enjoined from holding any claim in the premises adverse to the plaintiff, and that the plaintiffs title be quieted against the claims of said defendant and each of them.

It is further ordered that the guardian ad litem be allowed a fee of \$15.00, to be taxeed as costs, and that the costs be paid by the defendants.

COAL MINING LEASE.

THIS CONTRACT AND AGREEMENT, made and entered into on this 7" day of October, 1909, by and between Chief Harrison, as guardian of Anna Harrison, of Muskogee, County, Oklahoma, party of the first part, and A.D. Hayes, of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH:

That the said party of the first part, pursuant to an order of the county court within and for Muskogee county, Oklahoma, duly made and entered on the 7" day of 0 ctober, 1909, has leased, let and demised and by these presents does lease, let and demise unto the party of the second part, his helrs and assigns, for coal mining purposes, the following described premises, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

The southwest quarter of se ction ten (10), in township nineteen (19) North, of range thirteen (13) east, I.M. / containing one hundred sicty (160) acres, more or less.

Together with the sole and exclusive right to enter and be upon said premises for the full term of the minority of the said Anna Harrison, a minor, and until she becomes eighteen (18) years of age, to-wit: Until the 7" day of January, 1915, together with the right, during the term of this lease, to operate the coal mines now upon said premises, and to open and operate such other mines as the said party of the second part may desire, and to remove coal therefrom, together with the right to erect such buildings, lay such taxeks, and construct, such other improvements and appeatus, as may be necessary, or convenient, in the mining removal or transportation of coal, on or from said premises.
