ORDINANCE NO. 533 6/15/

An ordinance to provide for the vacation of a portion of the alley lying West and contiguous and parallel to the West line of lots 2 and 3, of Block 203 in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and making disposition of the same.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA. SECTION 1. That the portion of the 20 foot alley running from 12th, street to the South boundary of the Original Town site of Tulsa, lying west and contiguous and parallel to lots 2 and 3 in Block 203, described as follows:

Beginning at a point 183.5 feet south of the North East corner of Lot 4, Block 203 and along the east line of Lot 4, thence Southeasterly 61 feet, thence Easterly on the South Boundary line of said Original Townsite of Tulsa 21.8 feet thence Northwesterly 106.4 feet along the west line of Lots 2 and 3, thence Southwesterly 60 feet to point of beginning. According to the plat heretofore filed, be and the same is hereby vacated and said tract so vacated shall revert to the abutting lots 2 and 3, in Block 203, Tulsa, Oklahoma.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
