AGREEMENT, made and entered into the 7th day of January A.D.1910 by and between Carl Anderson of Tulsa, Cklahoma, party of the first part and John A. Steel of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the second part.

Witnesseth, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of one Pollar to him in hand well and truly paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby admortedged, and of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained on the eart of the said party of the second part, to be paid, kept and performed has granted and conveyed, and by these presents does grant and convey unto the said party of the second part his heirs or assigns, for the sole and only purpose of mining and operating for oil and gas, and of laying pipe lines, and of buildings tanks, stations and structures thereon to take care of the said products. All that certain tract of land situate in Tulsa County, Oklahome, to-wit:
