DEED--General Warranty

COMPARED

THIS INDENTURE, made 10th day of January 1910 between The Tulsa Addition Company, a Corporation, having its principal place of business at Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the first part and Warren L. Craig, of Tulsa, Okla. party of the second part.

Witnesseth: That said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Twenty five (\$425.00) Dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, all the following described real estate situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot six (6) in Block Thirty three (33) in the Cwen Addition to the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the amended plat thereof, dated April 25, 1907, and duly filed for record.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with and the singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

Party of the first part for itself, its successors and assigns does hereby warrant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the time the deliver of these presents, it is lawfully seized in its own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises with all the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances of what nature or kind soever and that it will warrant and forever defend the same unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns against said party of the first part its successors and all and every persons or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
