Hart & Harry Hart, her husband, do hereby great to The Prairie Cil & Gas Corrany, its successors or assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain, operate and remove a ripe line for the transportation of oil or gas and erect, mailthain and operate a telegraph or telephone line, if the same shall be found necessary, on, over and through our lands, situate in Tulsa and Okrulgee Counties, State of Oklahoma, described as follows. to-wit:

with ingress and agrees to and from the same. The said grantors, heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except for the purposes hereinbefore granted to the said The Prairie Oil & Gas Company, which hereby agrees to pay any damages which may arise from the laying, maintaining and operating said ripo line; said damage if not mutually agreed upon, to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons, one thereof to be appointed by the said grantors, heirs or assigns, one by The Prairie Oil & Gas Company, its successors or assigns, and the third by the two so appointed as aforesaid, and the award of such three persons shall be final and conclusive.

Amd it is hereby further agreed, that the said The Prairie Oil & Gas Company, its successors or assigns may at any time lay an additional line of pipe alongside of the first line, as herein provided, upon the payment of a like consideration, and subject to the same conditions; also to have the right to change the size of its pipes, the damage, if any, in making such change to be paid by the said The Prairie Oil & Gas Company. Said pire line to be buried below plow depth, and all telegraph or telephone poles to the set on section lines and no telegraph or telephone lines or poles to be built across land but same may be built along fences on section lines.
