THIS INDENTURE OF LEASE, Made and entered into in quadruplicate on this 3rd day of October A.D. 1905 by and betw een James W. Turly, Guardian of William B. Turly a Male Minor born Oct. 2th 1899 of Tulsa, Indian Territory party of the first part, and Lumbermans Oil and Gas Company of Bartlesville, Indian Territory, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Indian Territory, and authorized to carry on business in the Indian Territory by compliance with the laws in force therein, party of the second part, under and in pursuance of the provisions of Section 72
