

viaducts shall be six (6) feet wide, and the lower portion of which shall be constructed eleven feet six inches (11' 6") above the finished surface of the pavement to be constructed on said tract of land. The other of which bridges or viaducts shall be constructed four feet (4') wide and the lower portion of which shall be constructed sixteen (16') above the finished surface of said pavement to be constructed on said tract of land. Both of which said bridges or viaducts shall be fitted with railings or banisters on the sides thereof, three feet (3') high and all of said work shall be securely attached to the buildings on either sides of said tract of land and said bridges or viaducts shall be built of iron, except the flooring thereof, which may be composed of oak lumber. All of the said workmanship shall be strictly first class and said work shall be constructed in accordance with the requirements of the laws and ordinances of the City of Tulsa pertaining thereto. It being understood and agreed that the said permission hereby given to the said party of the second part to construct and maintain the aforesaid viaducts or bridges may be revoked by said first parties whenever the said viaducts or bridges shall become injurious to the property rights of said first parties, or any one of them.

Nothing herein granted shall be construed to effect or abridge any of the provisions of a certain contract concerning the above described tract of land, heretofore entered into between the first parties to this agreement, and which said contract is now of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and is recorded in Book 52 at page 204, under date of 2th day of April 1909.
