ORDER CONFIRMING DEED.

Now on this 11th day of January, 1910, came on to be heard the petition of Mattie Howard and Mose Chisholm, the sole and only heirs at law of Fannie Chisholm, deceased.

Said petitioners appearing in person, and after hearing the testimony of witnesses the court being fully advised in the premises finds:

That Fannie Chisholm was a full-blood Creek Indian and duly enrolled as such; that by reason of which she had allotted to her the following described real estate, now situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit: The Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty Four (24) Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base and Meridian.

The court further finds that the said Fannie Chisholm died intestate and without issue on the 4th day of July, 1906, at Coweta, in what is now Wagoner County, State of Oklahoma; that she left surviving her as her sole and only heirs at law, Mose Chisholm, her husband, Mattie Howard, her sister and Jeff Haynie, her brother; that since the death of Fannie Chisholm, the said Jeff Haynie died, intestate, unmarried, without issue and during infancy, in Wagoner County, Oklahoma, leaving as his sole and only heir at law, the said Mattie Howard, his sister; that the said Mose Chisholm and Mattie Howard are of legal age.

The court further finds that the said Mattie Howard and Mose Chisholm as the sole and only heirs at law of the said Fannie Chisholm, deceased, inherit each an undivided one half interest in and to the lands hereinbefore described; that on the 11th day of January 1910, the said Mattie Howard and Mose Chisholm made and executed to H.
