UHERRAS, a tornsite commission, heretofore appointed under the Act of Congress approved May 31, 1900 (31 Stat. 221) and acting under authority of the Act of Congress approved July 1, 1902 (32 Stat. 716) ratified by the Cherokee Mation August 7, 1902, has appraised the lots in the torn of Cwasso, Sherokee Mation, Indian Perritory, and

THERMAS, the plat of said torm was upproved by the Secretary of the Interior on the 26th day of March 1904 and was duly placed on file; and

WHEREAS,, said cormission has appraised all of the torn lots included in said plat at their true value, excluding improvements, which appraisal has been approved by the Secretary of the Interior; and

TEREAS, the said commission has awarded the real estate described hereinbelow to Town of Owasse who has raid Forty (\$40.00) Follars the full amount of the furchase price, into the treasury of the United States, to the credit of the Cherokee Nation of Indians, with the United States Indian Agent. at Muskogee, Indian Perritory, and is, therefore, entitled to a patent:

Now, Therefore, I, the undersigned the Principal Chief of the Cherokee Lation, do, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the aforesaid Act of the Corress of the United States, horeby grant, sell, and convey unto the said Town of Owasso its successors and assigns forever, all the right, title, and interest of the Cherokee Lation, aforesaid, in and to the CAMETERY more fully described as follows,: The £ 1/2 of the £.T. 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4 of the E.T. 1/4 of Section 29, Township 21 North, Range 14 Tast, containing 5 acres near the town of Owasso, Cherokee Lation, Indian Territory, and according to the plat thereof on file as aforesaid.
