RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT.

For and in consideration of the sum of Twenty two 50/100 (\$22.50) dollars to her in hand paid by The Oklahoma Natural Gas Company the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged Martha Naharkey, Guar. Millie Naharkey, minor does hereby grant to the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, a corporation, its successors or assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain, operate relay and remove a pipe line for the transportation of oil or gas and erect maintain, operate and remove telegraph or telephone lines with right of ingress and egress to and from the same, said right of way being more fully described by plat of definite location, approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 29, 1909, on over and through certain lands allotted to Martha Naharkey a citizen of the Creek Nation, Roll No. C 4363, situate in the county of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, and described as follows:

West 1/2 of NE 1/4 section 35, Township 19 Range 12.

The said grantors, their heirs, or assigns are to fully use and enjoy the said premises except the easements for the purposes hereinbefore granted to the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, its successors and assigns.
