COMPARED

C.B. Farquharson, makes oath and says that he is now and was on all the dates hereinafter mentioned, doing business in the city of Tulsa, said County and State, under the business name and style of The Tulsa Boiler and Sheet Iron Works. That exhibit "A" hereto annexed is a true and correct account of the use of a steam boiler furnished by said C. B. Farquharson to and for one W.W. Rains at said County, under an oral contract between said C.B. Farquharson and said W.W. Rains to the effect that for the use of said steam boiler, he the said W.W. Rains, would pay unto the said C.B. Farquharson the sum of One Dollar per day for each and every day beginning with and including October 21st, until such time as he the said W.W. Rains would return said boiler to said C. B. Farquharson; and that the use of said steam boiler should be used in the drilling of an oil and gas well upon the following tract of land, to-wit: The Northeast quarter of the southeast quarter, less 2.48 acres St Louis & San Francisco R.R. right of way; and the East One half of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter and the east one-half of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter all of section 15, township 19 North, or Range 12 east, containing eighty acres, more or less, and being in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, of which W.W. Rains was the owner. And that upon the completion of said well, or when the said W.W. rains was through the use of said boiler he would return the same to the place of business of the said C.B. Farquharson. Affiant further says that the said steam boiler actually used in the drilling of an oil and gas well upon the said above described land, and that said well was begun on or about September 10th, and is not as yet completed; that said boiler was furnished from October 21st, 1909 to January 9th 1910, inclusive, for the drilling of said oil and gas well and that part of the same has been paid and there is now due \$90.00 to this affiant. Wherefore Affiant claims a lien in the sum of \$90.00 with interest at 6% from Jan. 9 1910 upon said above described land, and the oil and gas well and its appurtenances to the extent of the interest of the said W.W. Rains in and to said described land and said oil and gas well, as and of the date of the commencement of the said oil and gas well, to-wit: September 10th, 1909.
