All payments which may fall due under this lease may be made direct to Edward Parris, or deposited to his credit in First Natl. Bank of Tahlequah.

The party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, shall have the right at any time on payment of ---- Dollars to parties of the first part, their heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, to surrender this lease for cancellation, after which all payments and liabilities thereafter to accrue under and by virtue of its terms shall cease and determine.

All covenants and agreements herein set forth between the parties hereto shall extend to their heirs executors, administrators, successors and assigns.
