alteration of said lines of pipe to be assessed under the direction of the Secretary, of the Interior, or, in case of removal of restrictions as to the then owner thereof, said damages, if not mutually agreed upon to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons, one thereof to be appointed by the owner of the premises, one by the Oklahoma Hatural das Company, its successors or assigns, and the third by the two so appointed as aforesaid, and the award of such three persons shall be final and conclusive.
