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Assignment.

This agreement made and executed this 19<sup>th</sup> day of January 1910 by A.M. Hackett, of Kansas City, Missouri, party of the first part to Pearl B. Remington of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the second part, Witnesseth.

Whereas, the said Pearl B. Remington and the said A.M. Hackett are each the owners of an undivided one half interest in and to the following described property situated in the city of Red Fork, County of Tulsa, <sup>State of</sup> Oklahoma, to-wit: ascertain brick plant operated and conducted under the firm name and style of the Red Fork Brick Company, together with a lease covering the premises upon which said plant is situated and all the appurtenances thereto belonging, or in anywise appertaining and,

Whereas the said parties are each the owners in fee simple of an undivided one half interest in and to the following described real estate situated in the city of Eureka, State of Kansas, to-wit: Lot eight (8) in Block eighteen (18) in the city of Eureka Kansas, according to the recorded plat thereof, together with the buildings and appurtenances thereon, or in any wise appertaining thereto.

Whereas, the said party of the second part, Pearl B. Remington by a certain indenture dated the 19th day of January 1910, has conveyed all of her right, title and interest in and to the said Lot eight (8) in Block Eighteen (18) in the city of Eureka, Kansas, said estate so conveyed by said indenture being made upon the express condition, to-wit: Said A.M.
