RENTAL CONTRACT.

THIS LEASE, made this 19 day of January 1910 by and between Asia Still Guardian of Cornelious and Chester Still minors of Cherokee City, Ark. part of the first part, and F.W. Taylor & Co of Vera, Okla. party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, that the said party of the first part, in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth, do by these presents, lease unto the second party, the following described property situated in the County of Tulsa State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The W 1/2 of N.W. 1/4 being the allotment of Cornelious Still minor and The E 1/2 of N.W. 1/4 " " " " Chester Still all Section 2, Township 22, N. Range 13 East, containigh 160 acres, for agricultural purposes.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the second party from the 19 day of January 1910 to the 19 day of January 1911 and said second party, in consideration of the presents here in set forth agrees to pay to the party of the first part, as rental for the above described premises,

Forty five (\$45.00 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.

It is further agreed that at the end of this lease, the second party shall give peaceabl possession of the premises to the first party.

It is understood by and between the parties hereto, that the terms of this lease shall extend to and be binding upon their heirs executors and assigns.
