

QUIT CLAIM DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 29th day of May 1907 between Amanda Myrtle (a widow woman) and - - - - - his wife party of the first part, of the Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory, Northern District, and Guardian Trust Company party of the second part, of Talleguah, Indian Territory.

WITNESSETH: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (1.00) Dollars to her in hand paid by the said party of the second part, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged has remised released, sold, conveyed, quitclaimed and by these presents does remise release, sell and convey and grant unto the said party of the second part its heirs and assigns forever, the right to perpetual occupancy thereof, and do also grant and assign all the right, title, interest, claim and possession which the said party of the first part have in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land, situated in The Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory, and described as follows, to-wit:

The south east quarter of the south west quarter and the north east of the south west quarter of south west quarter of section Nine (9) Township Twenty Two (22) Range Thirteen (13) East. This deed is made to correct a deed, heretofore executed by Amanda Myrtle, dated 8/16/04. Said deed having a defective acknowledgment.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereto belonging or appertaining and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim of the said party of the first part, either in law or equity forever.
