

each of them, contained and shall not do or fail to do any act or thing whereby said leases, or any of them might be forfeited, annulled or cancelled, according to the terms and conditions thereof, then this instrument shall be null and void; but, if said party of the first part, its successors or assigns, fail, neglect, or refuse to do any or all of the things hereinbefore set forth, or shall make default in the full performance of each, any and all of the conditions and stipulations in this agreement set forth, or shall fail, neglect or refuse to pay said notes, or either of them, and interest thereon as the same become due and payable, then and thereupon all of said notes and indebtedness shall immediately be due and payable and this contract shall be and remain in full force and effect and foreclosure may be had by the parties of the second part, their heirs or assigns, or either of them according to law.

This agreement shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of all parties hereto.
