

Order accepting proof of heirship and approving Oil and Gas Lease  
To Levi Ackley.

Now on this 29th day of January 1910, the same being one of the regular Judicial days of the Judge of above mentioned Court, sitting in Probate, the above matter came on to be heard upon the petition of said lessee, together with the affidavits of disinterested parties, and the said lessors being present and examined, and a certified copy of enrollment record at Muskogee, being produced, the petitioner and lessors asking for the acceptance of the Proof of Heirship and the approval of Oil and Gas lease, executed on the 26th day of January, 1910, by and between Waitie Mitchell and Mandy Mitchell, sole heirs of Cheparney Mitchell, to Levi Ackley of Muskogee, upon the following lands to wit: Lot one in section (8) eight township nineteen (19) north, range eleven (11) east of Indian Meridian and the east half of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and Lot six, less railroad right of way, and Lot seven, less railroad right of way, all in section five, township Nineteen north, range eleven east of the Indian Meridian, and containing about one hundred sixty nine and one half acres, more or less, situated and being in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, and the court being fully advised in the premises and being of the opinion that the approval of the oil and gas lease above described will be for the best interest of said heirs, and finding that Cheparney died in McIntosh County.

It is therefore ordered, Adjudged and Decreed by the court the Judge sitting as such in probate matters, That the proof of Heirship of Waitie Mitchell and Mandy Mitchell be declared be accepted as such, and they found as such sole and only rightful heirs, and that the oil and gas lease be and the same is hereby approved, ratified and confirmed.
