

And it further appearing that it is for the best interest of said minor to have said above described land developed for oil and gas, in order that funds may be obtained for the proper care, support, maintenance and education of said minor, and that said estate of said minor is not financially able to develop said land for oil and gas purposes.

And it further appearing that said Bill Hawkins as such guardian, has executed and delivered to Gardner Steele an oil and gas lease on the above described land and has received therefor the sum of \$80.00; and it further appearing that the bonus offered therefor is a good and sufficient bonus for said oil and gas lease.

It is therefore, considered, ordered and adjudged by the court that the said oil and gas lease, so made and executed as aforesaid, by the said Bill Hawkins as guardian of the above named minor ward, and covering the lands above described, be and the same is in all manner and things hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.

ORDER CONFIRMING OIL AND GAS LEASE.

And now on this 21 day of January 1910, coming on to be heard the report of Milton Ragsdale, guardian of Dollie Nevins, showing full compliance with the order of this court heretofore entered to-wit: On the 18th day of January, 1910, authorizing and directing said guardian to make an oil and gas lease covering the lands of his said ward to Gardner Steel, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and to submit said lease when executed to the Court for approval.

And the court having examined the report of the guardian and the oil and gas lease executed by said guardian and submitted in connection with said report, and it appearing to the Court that the said Guardian has fully complied with the orders of Court heretofore entered and with the Statute in such case, made and provided; and that it will be for the best interest of the estate of said minor; that said lease should be approved, and the Court being sufficiently advised it is therefore ordered and decreed that said oil and gas lease made and entered into on the 18th day of January, 1910, by
