Now on this 28th day of December 1909 comes Dr. O.P. Kernodle and files his bill of Particulars herein in which he alleges that Rufus Severns and Lizzie Severns his wife is justly indebted to him on a certain account in the sum of One Hundred and Thirty dollars and Seventy five cents (\$130.75) and prays that summons issue thereupon and thereupon summons is issued returnable on the 7th day of January 1910 and the cause set for hearing on the 7th day of January 1910 and said summons is placed in the hands of J.B. Ellis, Constable of above named township for service.

January 7, 1910 comes the plaintiff in person and defendants failing to appear are now each three times loudly called and comes not but herein wholly makes default whereupon this cause is submitted to the court for trial without the intervention of a Jury and the evidence being heard and the cort being fully advised finds far the plaintiff that there is due and owing from defendants to Plaintiff the sum of \$120.75

It is therefore adjudged by the cort that plaintiff recovers of and from the defendants the sum of One Hundred and twenty dollars and Seventy five cents (\$120.75) together with the cost herein taxed at \$3.75.
