Twenty dollars (\$20.00) cash in hand the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) on or before each succeeding January 1st, during the life of this lease. All rents payable by check sent by mail to First Party's postoffice address, -First party to keep second party advised of any change in postoffice address.

HEREBY WAIVING the benefit of Exemption valuation and appraisal laws of said State of Oklahoma, to secure the payment thereof.

The covenants herein shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs executors and administrators of the parties to this lease.
