WITNESSETH, that the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) dollars to them duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have remised, released, and quit claimed and by these presents do for themselves their heirs, executors and administrators, remise, release, and forever quit claim unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all their right, title, interest estate and claim and demand, both at law and in equity, of, in, and to all of Lot Eight (8) Block Three (3) Hodge Addition to the city of Tulsa Oklahoma as is shown by the recorded plat thereof

Crewson heirs and assigns; so that neither the said parties of the first part or any person in their name and behalf shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the said premises or any part thereof; but they and every one of them shall by these presents be excluded and forever barred.
