THIS INDENTURE, made this 11th day of December 1908, between H.F. Newblock Sheriff of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, party of the First Part and A.F. Ault of Tulsa Oklahoma, Party of the Second Part.

Whereas, at the September 1906, term of the United States District Court within and for the Western District of the Indian Territory, held at the Court House in the City of Tulsa, in said District on the 12th day of January, 1907, it was, among other things, ordered, adjudged and decreed, by the said Court in a certain action then pending in the said Court wherein T.E.
