ORDER CONFIRMING LEASE.

On this 22nd day of January 1910, the same being one of the regular days of the January 1910, term of Court, there coming on to be heard, the petition of Richard R. Clark, as guardian of the above named minr ward, for the confirmation and approval of a certain oil and gas mining lease, executed by said Richard R. Clark as such Guardian, to F.E.
