ORDER APPROVING DEED.

This cause coming on to be heard this day upon the petition of Nancy Long Nee Bigpond, one of the heirs at law of Daniel Bigpond, deceased, praying for an order of this Court approving a warranty deed executed by the said Nancy Long Nee Bigpond and Henry Long, her husband, to H.U. Bartlett on the 15th day of December, 1908, wherein and whereby the said Nancy Long Nee Bigpond and Henry Long, as heirs of the said Daniel Bigpond, deceased, did grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said H.U. Bartlett, the following described lands situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

Her dower interest in the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of Section Eight (8) Township Sixteen (16) Range Thirteen (13)

And it appearing to the Court that the said Daniel Bigpond in his lifetime was a duly enrolled full blood Indian citizen of the Creek Nation; and that as such citizen of the Creek Nation had allotted to him the above described lands; and it further appearing to the Court that the said Daniel Bigpond departed this life on the 28th day of April, 1907, within that portion of the Creek Nation now within the limits of Okmulgee County, Oklahoma; that the said Daniel Bigpond at the time of his death left surviving him, as his sole and only heirs at law, his wife, the said Nancy Long Nee Bigpond, and his two minor children, Albert Bigpond and Eliza Bigpond, and it appearing that Nancy Long nee Bigpond is a full blood citizen of the Creek Nation, and is of full age; and the court being fully advised in the premises finds;

That it has full and complete jurisdiction of the parties hereto and the subject matter hereof; that the said Nancy Long nee Bigpond is an heir of the said Daniel Bigpond, deceased; that the consideration paid for the said deed is adequate and that the said Nancy Long nee Bigpond had good right to sell and convey said land at the time of the execution of said deed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED CONSIDERED AND ADJUDGED, that under and by virtue of the power ^{vested} in this court by the provisions of Section 9 of the Act of Congress approved May 27 1908, the said deed so executed as aforesaid, which is here now presented to the court and is attached hereto, is in all things fully confirmed and approved.
