ORDER FOR REMOVAL OF RESTRICTIONS

Whereas Aggie Dazzler an allottee of the Cherokee Nation, has made application for the removal of restrictions from the following described land, to-wit:

Southeast quarter (SE/4) of Southeast quarter (SE/4) of Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of Section Thirty six (36) Township Twenty (20) North, range Thirteen (13) East, and the Southeast quarter (SE/4) of Southeast quarter (SE/4) of Southeast quarter (SE/4) of Section Thirty-five (35), Township Twenty (20) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, and Lot Four (4) and Lot Three (3) less one and 24/100 (1.24) acres right of way of K.O.C. & S.R.R. of Section One (1) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base and Meridian - 51.42 acres.

NOW THEREFORE, I, under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908 (Public No. 140) and the regulations prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the restrictions from said above described land, such removal of restrictions to become effective only and simultaneously with the execution of deed by said allottee to the purchaser after said land has been sold in compliance with the directions of the Secretary of the Interior.
