WHEREAS, MARY JANE MCKEE, Nee HODGE an allottee of the CREEK Nation, has made application for the removal of restrictions from the following described land, to-wit:

The west half (W/2) of the Southeast quarter (SE/4) of the North east quarter (NE/4) and the Northeast quarter (NE/4) of the Southeast Quarter (SE/4) of the Northeast quarter (NE/4) of Section Six (6) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, 30 acres.

NOW THEREFORE, I, under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1906, (Public No. 140), and the regulations prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the restrictions from said above described land, such removal of restrictions to become effective only and simultaneously with the execution of deed by said allottee to the purchaser after said land has been sold in compliance with the directions of the Secretary of the Interior.
