Howard, of Tulsa, Tulsa, County, Oklahoma, party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and confessed, has bargained, sold, granted, conveyed and transferred and by these presents does bargain, sell, grant, convey and transfer and deliver to the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns, the following described goods and chattels, now situate in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, on the land owned by the said party of the first part, same being described as follows, to-wit:

The Southeast quarter of the Northwest Quarter, and the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter, and the East Half of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter and the West Half of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter and the West Half of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast Quarter, all in Section 22, Township 19, North, Range 12 East, of the Indian Meridian.
