

royalty of one eighth (1/8) of all oil produced on said premises, for \$80.00 per year payable in advance after the first year for each year lessee defers drilling a well on said premises, for \$150.00 per year for each gas well produced on said premises where gas is used therefrom for any other purpose than in operating wells on said premises.

And it appearing to the court that said guardian did enter into and make an oil and gas lease upon the premises above described to John F. Hayden, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for 16 years and not longer than during the remainder of the minority of said Lawrence Davis, a minor, and upon the terms and conditions heretofore stated and that he has complied with the said order of this court in all things pertaining to making said oil and gas mining lease.

It is therefore by the court considered, ordered and decreed that the oil and gas lease entered into by J. S. Davis, guardian of Lawrence Davis, a minor, on the 28th day of January 1910, with John F. Hayden, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, upon the lands heretofore described, be and the same is hereby approved and confirmed.

WAIVER OF OBLIGATION UNDER BOND

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, whereas, on the 8th day of July 1908, the Secretary of the Interior approved an oil and gas mining lease on the allotment of Aggie Dazzler, said allotment embracing the following described lands:
