

That George Given, was a full blood Creek Indian, and duly enrolled as such; that by reason thereof, he had allotted to him the following described real estate, to-wit: The SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ in Sec. 21 and W $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and W $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 22, all in Tp. 19 N. R. 10 East.

The Court further finds that the said George Given, died in McIntosh County, ^{Okla} intestate on the----day of in Spring of 1900---190---, leaving as one of his heirs at law John Davis-----

all of whom are of full and legal age;

The Court further finds that the said George Given, had no issue born to him since the fourth day of March Nineteen hundred and six;

The court further finds that the said John Davis, as one of the heirs at law of the said George Given, deceased, on the 3rd day of March, 1910 made, executed and delivered to B.H. Harrison their certain warranty deed, conveying to said B.H. Harrison all of my right, title and interest, same being a one third undivided interest, in and to the above described land;

The Court further finds that the consideration of Two Hundred Dollars, for the above described land as aforesaid, is adequate, and that the same has been paid by said B.H. Harrison, to the legal representatives of the said George Given, allottee, deceased.

It is Therefore, here now, by the Court, considered, ordered, adjudged and decreed that the deed as presented herewith be and the same is hereby approved according to Section 9, of an Act of Congress approved May 27th, 1908, entitled an act for the Removal of Restrictions from part of the Lands of the Allottees of the Five Civilized Tribes, and for other Purposes (Public No. 140)

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That, I James Nail of the Creek Nation, in the Indian Territory, party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Sixty & 84/100 Dollars, paid to P. H. Vannest my step Father and Legal guardian for said James Nail, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the Missouri Kansas and Oklahoma Railroad Company, a corporation created and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Territory of Oklahoma, party of the second part, its
