TRANSFERABLE ONLY WITH CONSENT OF THE SECRETARY OF THE INTERIOR
OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE UPON LAND SELECTED FOR ALLOTMENT CHEROKEE NATION,
INDIAN TERRITORY.

(Sects. 72 Act of July 1, 1902, 32 Stat L. 716-726)

THIS INDENTURE OF LEASE, Made and entered into in quadruplicate on this 27th day of July A.D. 1907, by and between Taylet Morgan, of Eureka, Ind. Ter. party of the first part, lessor, and Duquense Oil and Gas Co of Bartlesville, Indian Territory, and Pittsburg, Penn. party of the second part, lessee, under and in pursuance of the provisions of section 72 of the act of Congress approved July 1, 1902, and the regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior thereunder.

WITNESSETH, that the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the royalties, covenants, stipulations and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed by the party of the second part its heirs, successors, and assigns do hereby demise, grant, and let unto the party of the second part, its heirs, successors, and assigns, for the term of fifteen years from the date hereof, all of the oil deposits and natural gas in or under the following described tract of land, lying and being within the Cherokee Indian Nation and within the Indian Territory, to-wit: The
