OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE UPON LAND SELECTED FOR ALLOTMENT CREEK NATION OKLAHOMA.

THIS INDENTURE OF LEASE, Made and entered into in quadruplicate on this twenty second day of November, A.D. 1909, by and between Lizzie Enriques, nee Gooden of Wekiwa, Oklahoma, a-----, citizens of the Creek Nation, party of the first part, hereinafter designated as the lessor, and Earle T. Miller of Muskogee, Oklahoma, party of the second part hereinafter designated as lessee, under and in pursuance of the provisions of the act of Congress approved May 27 1908, (Public No. 140) witnesseth:

1. The lessor, for and in consideration of one dollar, the receipt whereof is acknowledged and of the royalties, covenants, stipulations, and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed and performed by the lessee, does hereby demise, grant, lease and let unto the lessee, for the term of five years from the date of the approval hereof by the Secretary of the Interior, and as much longer thereafter as oil or gas is found in paying quantities, all the oil deposits and natural gas in or under the following described tract of land lying and being within the
